Biola's Church Matching Scholarship was developed to encourage churches to support students from their congregation who are pursuing Christian higher education. The awarding of the scholarship will be based strictly on the guidelines listed on the back of this form. CHURCH MATCHING SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

ADDITIONAL APPLICATION REQUIRED

- Church Matching Scholarship applicants who are **U.S. Citizens or permanent residents must file a 2007-2008 FAFSA** by the scholarship deadline. *Exception: ELSP students and Doctor of Ministry students are not required to file a FAFSA.*
- International student are not required to file a FAFSA. No further applications are required.

SCHOLARSHIP TERMS

- **The student must be enrolled full time for the full match.** The match will be prorated according to the student's enrollment status if less than full-time. To be eligible, undergraduate students must be enrolled for at least 6 units and graduate students must be enrolled in at least 5 units.
- Deadlines are as follows:
 - October 1, 2007 for students who are enrolled for the full year, or are only enrolled in the fall semester.
 - March 3, 2008 for students who are only enrolled for the spring semester.
- Students who were enrolled in the fall and did not receive a Church Matching Scholarship are ineligible for one in the spring.
- The scholarship will be coordinated with need-based financial aid and is based on availability of funds.
- The church may not submit funds from wages, internships, or gifts from individuals for specific students.
- Only one church scholarship check per year will be matched up to \$700 for undergraduate students and \$500 for graduate students. Subsequent checks will not be matched.
- **Exceptions or extensions will not be granted.**

PROGRAM ELIGIBILITY

- Students who entered the Doctor of Ministry program after the Fall 2006 semester are ineligible for the Church Matching Scholarship.
- Doctor of Ministry students who began enrollment prior to the Fall 2006 semester are eligible for up to \$250 per semester.
- ELSP students are eligible for one Church Matching Scholarship during their first two semesters of enrollment. No matches will be approved subsequent to that time.
- School of Professional Studies programs, including but not limited to MOL, MA Apologetics, and BOLD, are not eligible for the Church Matching Scholarship.
