Commentary, Evangelical Law Institute (ELI) (October 5, 2005) "Post-Borkian Stealth Nominees & The Health of The Federal Judiciary." I wrote a commentary criticizing President Bush's nomination of Harriet Miers

to the United States Supreme Court. ELI is my own organization founded to promote the integration of law and theology.

“Selective Bondage: Judicial Activism & the Decline of Religious Liberty” (November 2003) This paper was presented at the national meeting of the Evangelical Theological Society, Atlanta, GA. This paper argues that the church in America presently possesses less freedom than it enjoyed when the country was founded. State governments historically permitted and encouraged such activities as school prayer and the teaching of creation in the public schools until they were informed by the federal courts in the late 20th century that these practices were “unconstitutional.” This reduction of freedom was the result of an active federal “justiciary” usurping the legal prerogative of the states to make their own decisions regarding, *inter alia*, the relationship between the church and the state. This was primarily accomplished by applying the juridical theory of Selective Incorporation of the Bill of Rights. Through this practice the United States Supreme Court simply seized from the states their constitutional right to decide how high the metaphorical “Wall of Separation” should be built. The practical result of selective incorporation has been the progressive legal exclusion of theology from public life. This paper examines the doctrine of selective incorporation, traces its detrimental effects on religious liberty, and proffers a strategy to remedy the harms caused by it.

“Cults & Crime” (January 2003) This paper was presented at the Evangelical Ministries to New Religions Conference at Biola University. It examines the scope of the Free Exercise Clause of the United States Constitution as it relates to practices found in some cults and sectarian organizations.

People v. Curtis. Draft opinion for the California Court of Appeal, 4th District, Division 3 while clerking for Justice William Bedsworth (Fall 2001-Winter 2002). I researched and drafted legal opinion for the court on the issues of: (1) the duty of a court to appoint an independent psychiatric expert to prepare a report under Penal Code section 288.1 where probation was a possible sentence in a child molestation case; (2) the duty of the court to appoint counsel or make further inquiry into a defendant’s ability to pay for psychiatric assistance, and (3) the lower court’s alleged mistake of imposing the middle term sentence of twelve years, rather the lower term sentence of six years, because the probation officer allegedly failed to articulate “readily identifiable” factors in mitigation, regarding the defendant’s violation of Penal Code section 288.5—Continual Sexual Abuse of a Minor Under Age 14.

“The Seven Deadly Corporate Sins: Prosecuting Religious Corporations.” (Fall 2001) Seminar paper & presentation for Corporate Crime & Sentencing Seminar. The paper examines the line of demarcation where the First Amendment Free Exercise Clause ends and criminal prosecution begins.

“Human Personhood & The Law.” (Spring 2001) Seminar paper & presentation for Bioethics & the Law Seminar. The paper examines the legal definitions of personhood for the sake of the attachment of legal rights by having standing before the court and then argues for the adoption of a consistent legal definition of human personhood from the moment of conception.

“Behind the Cyber Curtain: Counter-terrorism & the Encryption Debate.” (Fall 2000) Seminar paper & presentation for Computers & the Law Seminar. The paper examines the balance of law enforcement’s need to be able to quickly crack strong encryption codes and the individual right to privacy.

People v. Martineau. Draft opinion for the California Court of Appeal, 4th District, Division 3 while clerking for Justice William Bedsworth (Spring 2000). Researched and drafted legal opinion for the court on the issue of the necessity of the trial court to instruct the jurors that they could not convict a defendant of criminal conspiracy unless they unanimously agreed that a particular overt act occurred after the conspiracy began.
